EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The BFA Dodoma Chapter held on May 25, 2024, at Zanka Primary School was a successful outreach initiative aimed at providing essential school materials to pupils and fostering a supportive environment for interaction and advice sharing. The event was successful with participation of 20 members of various Universities and 70 pupils,

with activities including the distribution of school supplies, interactive sessions, and communal dining. The total expenditure for the event was Tsh 964,000, which was used to buy school materials, Transport, and food, leaving a remaining balance of Tsh 55,000 from the total collected amount of Tsh 1,019,000



INTRODUCTION

The BFA Dodoma Chapter organized an outreach event at Zanka Primary School on May 25, 2024. The primary focus of the event was to provide school materials and create a safe space for interaction between BFA members and the pupils,

- To foster a sense of community through shared activities such as gift-giving, cutting cakes, and communal dining.

- Informative talks to educate the Members about the BFA.
- Cutting of cakes and communal dining to foster a sense of unity and celebration

- Ensuring the equitable distribution of school materials among the pupils due to increase of number pupils
- Managing time effectively to accommodate all planned activities within the schedule.

Outcomes

- Successful distribution of 80 packages of school materials, each costing Tsh 236,000.
- Strengthened bonds between BFA members and the pupils through meaningful interactions.
- Increased awareness about BFA's mission and activities within the school community.
